

學校簡介

奧格斯堡大學是德國巴伐利亞邦第三大城(奧格斯堡)的一所公立大學，成立於1970年。這是一間小小的大學，學校裡有一座湖泊，冬天湖泊結冰時非常漂亮，湖泊上還有一個鳥居，這是奧格斯堡和日本的尼崎和長濱為友好城市的象徵。學校就在電車站旁邊，交通非常方便，校內也設有學生餐廳，裡面的食物多樣化，選擇也非常多，付款是直接使用學生證，非常簡單快速；學校的行政人員並非都會講英文，如若遇到無法溝通或無法解決的問題，直接請國際處幫忙最直接快速；學校的各個學院分散在整條馬路上，商學院中多數課程為資管相關，學校的線上系統不太直觀，有時會需要學伴的幫忙。

國外研修之課程學習（課內），另外推薦受益最多/最喜歡的課程

我最喜歡的課是Exploring German Culture，這堂課以小組報告的形式進行，深入的介紹了奧格斯堡本地的文化以及歷史，也介紹了德國複雜的教育體制、保險制度、當地建築、音樂歷史等等，並且在報告的最後進行不同國家之間的差別比較，藉此機會了解到除了德國以外的文化。

國外研修之生活學習（課外）

學著如何和宿舍裡的其他人打點好關係，由於宿舍沒有收發室，貨運也不會通知包裹什麼時候會送到，以防包裹被偷走，請鄰居幫你代收包裹是最為快速安全的選擇。德國並非每個地區都很國際化，更多的是沒有英文標示和不會講英文的德國人，所以會一點德文是旅行必備，尤其德國的火車很常出問題，列車長廣播時很常只講德文，如若聽不懂德文，就必須趕緊向其他乘客詢問。

感言及心得感想

感謝中山給我機會，讓我以交換生的身份到奧格斯堡大學研修，在簽證的申請重也因學生身份方便了不少，也給予我機會能體會歐洲的風俗民情以及截然不同的生活模式，更感謝學校給予的獎學金，讓我在購買機票時無後顧之憂，在機票選擇上自由度大幅提升。在德國這五個月的時間讓我提昇了自我獨立思考的能力，更提升了我快速判斷和決策的能力。德國的生活讓我學會了放慢腳步，事情不需要看得太精細，出門在外時時保持警覺，凡事都要有備案，做好隨時更動的準備；凡事預留的時間多一點，需要走行政流程的事物更需提早，並需要多預留非常多的時間。德國課程教受的內容，更多是引導學生自己去理解和尋找課程內容的答案，與其說是上課，更像是自我學習，在查找資料中取得相關知識，如此不同的授課方式，讓我更進一步提升了我查找資料的能力。

University of Augsburg is founded in 1970, which is a public university in the third largest city (Augsburg) in Bavaria, Germany. This is a small university and has a pond inside the campus. The pond is very beautiful when it is frozen in winter. There is also a torii gate on the lake, which is a symbol of the friendship between Augsburg city, Amagasaki city and Nagahama city in Japan. Departments are scattered along the road, and most courses in business schools are related to information management.

The content taught during the courses in Germany is more likely to guide students to understand and find the answers by themselves to the course content. The classes aren't taught in the traditional way like in Taiwan, courses are more like self-study, and obtain relevant knowledge from searching materials. My favorite class is Exploring German Culture. This class deeply introduces the local culture and history of Augsburg, and also introduces Germany's complicated education system, insurance system, local architecture and history of music, etc.

Learning how to build a good relationship with other people in the dormitory plays an important role. Since there is no mail room in the dormitory, the mailman will not tell you when the package will be delivered. To prevent the package be stolen, it is the fastest way to ask your neighbors to help you collect the package.

Not every region in Germany is very international, and there are more cases like no English signs in the public and a lot of Germans do not speak English, so knowing a little German is a must for travel, especially German trains often have problems, and the train conductor often broadcasts only in German. The benefits from these five months are ability to think independently, ability to determine quickly, the Growth of patience and cooking skills progressed.

I'm very grateful to NSYSU for giving me the opportunity to study at the University of Augsburg as an exchange student. During the five months in Germany, I have improved my ability to think independently, and also improved my ability to determine and make decisions quickly. Life in Germany taught me to slow down. Things don't have to be so complicated too much, and needed more time reserved for everything. Things that need to go through administrative procedures need to be in the process earlier, and a lot of time is needed to be preserved.
