

學校簡介

列日 (Liège) 位於比利時法語區中東部，位處歐洲中心且鄰近荷蘭馬斯垂克 (Maastricht)、德國科隆 (Cologne) 及許多法國城市；同時也是比利時境內第三大城市，以在地的列日鬆餅 (Gaufre de Liège) 飄香而聞名，口感和布魯塞爾的方形鬆餅比較起來更為紮實，內包裹著甜而不膩的珍珠糖。

列日大學 (University of Liège) 是「瓦隆-歐洲大學院」的聯盟成員；也是「歐洲管理發展基金會」(EQUIS) 認證大學之一，自 1817 年由皇室成立，歷史相當悠久，學術蘊藏豐富，課程的選擇多元且彈性；歷經改革翻新設備資源及校園視覺，課堂互動及校方及師資與學生之間溝通活絡，學風十分自由。其在比利時國內的 3 座城市中含有 4 個校區，其中主要在列日市中分為兩個校區：一為在山區佔地最廣大的 Sart-tilman 主校區，包含了法政及犯罪學、社會科學、電機工程、航太科學、醫藥獸醫及心理學院，此外如：迎新日、校際足球賽、社團活動等許多項目也會在這裡舉辦；另一則為分布在市區中的 City Center 校區，散落著許多學院的建築物，如：文哲與行政大樓的 20-Août 校區、建築學院，以及 HEC 管理學院，包含了 Louvrex 路段上的大系館和 Opéra 商圈的小系館。

The University of Liège (French: Université de Liège), or ULiège, is a major public university of the French Community of Belgium based in Liège, Wallonia, Belgium. Its official language is French. As of 2020, ULiège is ranked in the 301 –350 category worldwide according to Times Higher Education, 451st by QS World University Rankings, and between the 201th and 300th place by the Academic Ranking of World Universities. More than 2,000 people, including academics, scientists and technicians, are involved in research of a wide variety of subjects from basic research to applied research.

The university was founded in 1817 by William I of the Netherlands, then King of the United Kingdom of the Netherlands, and by his Minister of Intellectual Education, Anton Reinhard Falck. The foundation of the university was the result of a long tradition which dates back to the origins of the Prince-Bishopric of Liège. Beginning in the eleventh century, the influence of the principality attracted students and prominent scientists and philosophers, such as Petrarch, to study in its libraries. The reputation of its medieval schools gave the city the reputation as a new Athens.

A 17 March 1808 decree by Napoleon I concerning the organization of an imperial university indicated Liège as the site of a new academy to be composed of a Faculty of Arts and a Faculty of Science—the first university charter for Liège. Ultimately, Liège owes its university to William I of the Netherlands, who remembered the city's prestigious legacy of teaching and culture when he decided to establish a new university on Walloon soil.

Nearly 200 years later, settled to some extent in the Sart-Tilman [fr] district of Liège, the University of Liège belongs to the French community of Belgium. The university is located at the edge of the river Meuse, in the center of the Island, the Latin Quarter of Liège. In 2009, the Agronomical University of Gembloux (FUSAGx), based in Gembloux, in the Province of Namur, integrated ULiège. It has adopted a new name for academics as well as research, namely Gembloux Agro- Bio Tech.

I took three courses in Liege University, which is Strategic Stakes in Globalization, Brand Management, French A1.

What I learn from the exchange?

1. The ability to solve problems and deal with things by yourself.
2. Experience a lot of different cultures from Taiwan, and connect with the world.
3. The ability to live alone, such as cooking.
4. Learn to enjoy being alone and entertain yourself.
5. Learn to cherish and appreciate what you have and not take it for granted.
6. Expand your vision, enhance your international outlook, expand your international vision, and make friends with people from different countries.
7. Be proud of your country (Taiwan), recognize Taiwan's advanced and warm, and understand Taiwan's unique culture.
8. Travel with insufficient funds, learn to do the most with the least money, and learn financial management.
9. Learn different languages and improve your communication and social skills.
10. Make good friends different from your hometown.

I suggest that before you go to other countries for exchange, you must first find what you want to learn abroad, and make sure that you want to do it for "you", not because "everyone" is doing it.
