26-2 國外研修之課程學習（課內）

很久以前就很想去歐洲念書，感受那的多元文化，尤其是德國—我景仰已久的國家，很想親身體驗這國家名聞遐邇的高品質教育，以及它為何如此強盛，無論是在政治、經濟，藝術文化方面，為此，也在去德國之前學了德文近兩年。在 LMU 開學前的一個月，參加了 IUCM(LMU 的語言中心)的德語課程 Preparation course 和 excursion program，非常棒！讓我認識了好多朋友及更熟悉德文和 LMU，也因為 excursion program 旅遊了好幾處。開學後，在 LMU 修習了 Strategy and Leadership、Human Resource Development、Methods in Management 三堂 Lecture 以及 IUCM 的德語課程，收穫甚大，雖然 Strategy and Leadership 是 Lecture，課間也是不停的討論，且在每堂 exercise 前還是要研讀 case，並和組員討論及上台報告，其餘兩堂課，教授也是非常鼓勵同學發言和互動討論，這完全顛覆我在台灣的學習模式，教授不會給你標準的制式答案，而是鼓勵你思考、用有邏輯的方式思辨，提出自己的想法。這邊的 Lecture 考試也是非常不簡單，一定要好好認真花時間準備，還都是一試定生死(沒有點名機制)。德國的 Universität 教學內容是以學術理論為主，以前的我都以為理論就是無趣，幾乎不實際，在 LMU 上課後，在那有邏輯、實事求是，刺激思考的教學內容和方法下，使我覺得非常有趣，也讓我對學術理論領域重新思考，原來它也不是全然枯燥。

I still can't imagine I can live and study in my dream city-Munich for a longer time till now. To reach the goal in Germany, I have learned German for almost two years in Taiwan before the exchange. Without doubt, it is still not enough to live in Germany if you want to live in a German way relying on German. As a result, I attended the preparation program of IUCM (International University Club Munich) for one month before the winter semester started. During the period I improved my German a lot especially for listening and speaking. Besides, I met lots of exchange students due to the program. One of the advantages is that you could have more time and opportunities to get to know and chat with new friends. Because after the semester starts, most of the exchange students have built their own friend circle and it is not too easy to make new friends as the language preparation time.

In addition to it, LMU IUCM also offered the excursion program inclusive of some tours and activities such as City tour of Munich by bus, visit of a performance at the national theater in Munich, the tour of Castle Neuschwanstein and Church Wieskirche, excursion to the concentration camp memorial site of Dachau and the city of Nuremberg tour. The excursions price by IUCM is very affordable and cheaper than other tour organizations. So don't miss the excursions if you were exchange students at LMU. It's very fun and convenient to experience south Germany.

The regular courses in management school at LMU are half English/half German. I took three English lectures including Strategy and Leadership, Human Resource Development, and Methods in Management and semester German course. The teaching way at LMU is totally different from the education system in Taiwan. Teachers at LMU don't give you the standard answers and they ask students to think, discuss and argue logically. One of the teachers always said "You have to have your own argument." Because the courses I took at LMU were all lectures, there was just only one final exam for each course and no attendance scores. I have never taken this kind of courses and felt stressed (The exams are not easy) so I made efforts to prepare them. Courses at universities in Germany focus more on theory. Before studying at LMU, I think academic theory of management is not so important and boring. However, studying at LMU changes my thoughts for it. Theory could be interesting and train logical thinking just depending on how to get to learn and study it.

The fun part in my exchange time is the WG (Wohngemeinschaft)-flat share life. Eight students lived in the WG and we did have a really great time there. We came from Taiwan, Germany, India, China, Turkey, Korea, Albania, and Pakistan. Also, some of them are second generation immigrants. In the WG, we chatted, cooked, shared food, and laughed together. I knew more different culture from my WG friends.

Even I am not in Munich now, the scenes and memories are still very true in my mind when I look back on it. I do enjoy and love the amazing city and people there!
