學校簡介

首爾大學，又稱國立首爾大學或首爾國立大學。建校以來，一直領導著韓國各學術界的發展，並為韓國培養出了一大批社會風雲人物，享有「韓民族最高學府」之稱。例如第8任聯合國秘書長潘基文及多位韓國總統均出身於首爾大學，是韓國最高學府。

首爾大學的前身是日本於1924年創立的京城帝國大學。是日本九所帝國大學的第六所。於1946年，由大韓民國政府改名為首爾大學。是韓國10所國立旗幟大學中最早建立的一所，一直是韓國國立大學的典範。首爾大學(SNU)與高麗大學(KU)和延世大學(YU)兩所私立大學，三所學校的英文名稱首字合併後，被稱為韓國大學的一片天(S.K.Y)。

Time flies, of all the exchange students I befriended in Seoul, some have backed to home countries as me, many are still there, but none of us have regretted the decision to seize the opportunity to study abroad.
