Japanese Language Courses:

- Japanese language courses are Undergraduate level courses. Though the courses are open to Graduate students, they cannot obtain credits for Japanese language courses.
- If a student has no language proficiency and wishes to study Japanese, they will need to study Hiragara and Katakana (reading AND writing) before arriving in Japan.
- The Intensive Beginner Course is a set of 6 classes, and students must take all 6 classes each week. These classes may cause clashes with other academic courses that students need to take. Therefore, if students have any essential academic courses to take at Chuo, they are strongly recommended to consult with the International Center of Chuo at the earliest opportunity before deciding to apply for the Chuo exchange program.
- Japanese language courses are primarily offered on the Tama Campus, and the intensive courses are only offered at Tama.
- Two Japanese language classes are offered on the Korakuen Campus for Science and Engineering major students. The course level is approximate JLPT N3 level.
