





STUDY IN CANADA SCHOLARSHIPS



Scholarships for students from eligible countries/territories to pursue study or research exchanges in Canada at the college, undergraduate and graduate levels.

NEW LIST OF COUNTRIES AND TERRITORIES

ELIGIBILITY:

- Students must be citizens of Algeria, Bangladesh, Burkina Faso, Egypt, Ethiopia, Ghana, Ivory Coast, Jordan, Kenya, Libya, Morocco, Nepal, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, Tanzania, Tunisia, Turkey, Uganda, and Ukraine. Students from Taiwan are also eligible.



How the post-graduation work permit (<u>PGWP</u>) eligibility is affected:

If you're inside Canada:


You're still eligible for the PGWP if:

- Your in-person classes in Canada have been moved to an online-only format and you are taking your classes online because; or
- You had to put your studies on hold, or study part-time, during winter, spring or summer 2020 semesters.

If you're outside Canada:

If you can't travel to Canada at this time and you're taking classes online, you're still eligible for a PGWP. To be eligible you must:

- Meet all the other PGWP requirements;
- have been enrolled in a program that was in progress in March 2020, or started or will start a program between spring 2020 and fall 2021.

How much of your studies count toward a PGWP:

- •You can complete **100%** of your studies online from outside Canada.
- •All your time studying online outside Canada **between spring 2020 and December 31**, **2021**, counts toward the length of a PGWP.

Time spent studying outside Canada after December 31, 2021, won't count towards the length of a PGWP.





- You need the following documents to apply:
 - Proof of acceptance
 - Valid passport
 - Proof of financial support
 - Letter of explanation
- There are two ways to apply:
 - Online
 - On paper

Study Permits 學生簽證

If you're applying for a study permit, you should <u>apply online</u>, whether you're outside of Canada or already in Canada. When you apply, you should submit:

- •the letter of acceptance issued to you by the designated learning institution (DLI) you'll be attending
- •as many of the <u>documents needed for a complete</u> <u>application</u> as possible
- •a letter of explanation for any documents that are missing due to COVID-19

If you **can't** apply online because of a disability or because there's a <u>problem with the online application</u>, you can apply on paper.

If you plan to <u>study in Quebec</u>, you must provide a valid Quebec Acceptance Certificate or proof that you applied for one.



Study Permits 最新入境規定

The Government of Canada announcement on March 17, 2022 :

Effective April 1, 2022, fully vaccinated travellers will no longer need to provide a pre-entry COVID-19 test result to enter Canada.

Fully vaccinated travellers seeking to arrive in Canada **before April 1**, 2022, must still have a valid pre-entry test.


Fully vaccinated travellers arriving to Canada may need to take a COVID-19 molecular test on arrival if selected for mandatory random testing.

Partially or unvaccinated travelers are currently allowed to travel to Canada, pre-entry testing requirements are not changing.

All travellers are required to submit their mandatory information in ArriveCAN before their arrival in Canada.

Government of Canada announces additional easing of border measures effective April 25

Unvaccinated or partially vaccinated children aged 5-11 who are accompanied by a <u>fully vaccinated</u> parent, step-parent, guardian or tutor will no longer be required to complete a pre-entry COVID-19 test for entry to Canada. Children under 5 years of age are not required to provide a COVID-19 test result. Pre-entry tests will still be required for partially vaccinated or unvaccinated travellers 12 and older who are <u>currently eligible to travel to Canada</u>.

All fully vaccinated travellers will no longer be required to provide a quarantine plan upon entry. All travellers are **still required** to use **ArriveCAN** (free mobile app or website) to provide mandatory travel information within 72 hours of their arrival to Canada and/or before boarding a plane or cruise ship destined for Canada, including:

contact and travel information, andvaccination information and proof of vaccination (if applicable).

Fully vaccinated travellers who do not submit their information into ArriveCAN:

•won't be eligible for the fully vaccinated traveller exemption (i.e., they may have to submit a pre-entry test result and suitable quarantine plan, quarantine and undergo testing in Canada);
•may face additional delays at the border for public health questioning; and
•may be subject to fines or other enforcement action.

All travellers, regardless of vaccination status, must also continue to wear a mask throughout their entire travel journey.

Immigration Friendly Policies 友善的移民政策

Canada has a number of immigration friendly policies that support pathways to permanent residency.

When surveyed, the majority of international students said they chose Canada with the intention of applying for permanent resident status at some point in the future.


