VISA

Admitted visiting students can apply for a visa at an overseas Taiwan embassy after receiving the Letter of Acceptance.

VISITOR VISA

Students who are staying in Taiwan for **less than 180 days (one semester)** should apply for a Visitor Visa.

With a Visitor Visa, each student may stay for 60/90 days and apply for a maximum of two extensions, each for 60/90 days.

The extensions should be made **2 weeks** before the 60/90 days are due.

RESIDENT VISA

Students who are staying in Taiwan for **more than 180 days (full academic year)** should apply for a Resident Visa. (The final decision will be made by the embassy.)

The Resident Visa must be changed to the Alien Resident Certificates (ARC) within 15 days after completing the quarantine.

INSURANCE & HEALTH CERTIFICATE

All international exchange students are required to purchase overseas travel insurance, and it must cover the whole duration of their stay in Taiwan.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

You are required to purchase overseas travel insurance with medical care and accident policies before coming to Taiwan.



The insurance plan **in English version** must be submitted upon registration.



It is mandatory for all NSYSU students to purchase Student Group Insurance.

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE

The fee is NTD329 per semester and it will be included in the tuition & fees payment bill, which should be paid upon registration period.

According to the National Health Insurance (NHI) Act, any international student who is **continuously staying in Taiwan for over six months** is eligible to join the NHI.

Once you are qualified to join the NHI, please inform OIA staff by email. If you have already joined the NHI program, please also inform OIA staff beforehand. The insurance fee will be included in the tuition & fees payment bill every semester.

<u>Health Certificate</u>

Students applied for 3-6 months study should complete their <u>health certificate form C</u> before coming to Taiwan.

Students applied for over 6 months study should complete the <u>health certificate form B</u> in their located country in order to apply for the residence visa.

TUITION & FEES

Visiting Students are required to pay tuition fees according to the length of study.

- 30 Days or Less: Tuition-waived.

- 31 to 60 Days: 1/3 Miscellaneous fee.

- More Than 60 Days: Full Miscellaneous fee.

MAKE THE PAYMENT

All visiting students can make the payment by cash at any Post Office and Bank of Taiwan. If the fee is less than NT20,000, the payment can also be made at any convenience store in Taiwan.





It is important to check with your bank for your weekly/monthly overseas withdrawal limitation.

The fees must be paid in a lump sum during the registration period.



Students can apply for on-campus dormitories when applying for the visiting program.

DORMITORY

On-campus housing affairs are managed by the Dorm Service Center.

International Students could be arranged to the International Dorm, Wu-ling Village 1/4, Dorm C, or Dorm L.

The room number will be shared with you by email 3-4 weeks before the semester starts.

DORM CHECK-IN

The OIA coordinator will let you know the date you can check in at the dorm. Please visit the designated dorm office to collect the keys.

Note that our dorms are located on the hills. Taking a taxi to the dorm office is the most efficient way while carry luggage.

You may ask the dorm staff if there are any supplies left by former students before buying new ones.

UNIVERSITY WIFI & REGISTRATION

TRANSPORTATION

DRIVER'S LICENSE

An international driving license is required to drive in Taiwan.

Students from countries with reciprocal agreements with Taiwan can use their international driving license for up to 30 days after the arrival date. After 30 days, it is required by law to have a R.O.C. (Taiwan) International Driver License Permit or R.O.C. (Taiwan) Driver License if you wish to continue driving in Taiwan.

If your country does not have a reciprocal arrangement with Taiwan for international driving licenses, you will need to sit a written test and take a driver's examination. You can find more information <u>here</u>.

• You will need a driving license to rent & ride a scooter in Taiwan.

VEHICLE RENTAL

Please search for a certified company for renting a scooter/car.

A clear contract should be signed by both sides. The company should present their validated certificate and you should be asked to show your international driver's license.

The rental company should purchase compulsory insurance for vehicles.

Renting scooter/car with an uncertified company will cause serious consequences and might be illegal.

PARKING ON-CAMPUS

You should apply for a parking permit to park your scooter on the campus. The fee is 300NTD per year.

If you didn't park your vehicle in designated areas, it could be towed.

Please visit the Vehicle Management Committee for applying for the parking permit.

WIRELESS NETWORK

The NSYSU campus is mostly covered by a wireless network named TANetRoaming.

For students who live in the dormitory, the university provides free internet with a limitation of 6GByte/day. If your usage exceeds the limitation, the internet will be locked for 7 days. Your internet will be automatically resumed on day 8.

Most of our dormitories are not covered by a wireless network, you can buy or bring a suitable cable for internet in the dorm.

Don't forget to bring an adapter for electrical appliances. The current in Taiwan is 110 volts.

OPEN A BANK ACCOUNT IN TAIWAN

We recommend you open a bank account at the Post Office if you carry a big amount of cash or if you will receive a stipend or scholarship.

SIM CARD

Please purchase a prepaid card from one of the mobile network carriers at the airport for quarantine use.

You can also purchase the sim card at the cellular company in the city.
