FAQ

In what languages courses are taught at ISC Paris ?

At ISC Paris, you can study in French and in English.

What language level is required to come and study at ISC Paris ?

- **TOEFL IBT** test minimum score: 79/120 points
- **TOEFL ITP** test minimum score: 543/677 points
- **TOEIC** test minimum score: 785/990 points
- **IELTS** test minimum score: 6.5 points
- **Duolingo** test minimum score: 90 points
- **Cambridge** minimum score : B2
- **CEFR** (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, for students who wish to take course taught in French): minimum score B2

Please note that we only accept proficiency documents submitted in English. The English test must have been taken within 2 years of the result date.

Transcript of records

The official transcript will be sent by email, with the coordinator in copy, approximately 30 to 45 days after the semester ends.

Do you offer a language course for incoming students and what are the costs ? Can students obtain ECTS ?

FLE (**French as a second language**) is mandatory for all exchange students. The course is worth 2 ECTS. Additionally, students can enroll in one online language course (2 ECTS).

What is the minimum workload required?

The **minimum** workload required is 15 ECTS, which corresponds to 5 to 6 courses.
