Q: What language are the classes taught in?

A: All classes are taught 100% in English.

Q: Do I need a visa to visit Korea?

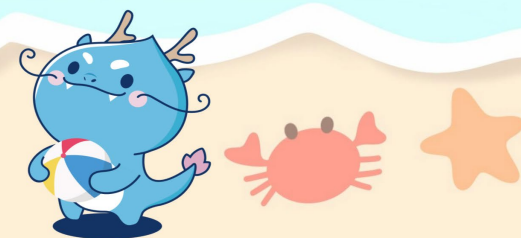
A: Taiwan passport holders can visit Korea visa-free for up to 90 days.

Q: Besides the program fee, how much is the cost of living in Korea?

A: The cost of living around campus is relatively low, but popular areas like Myeongdong or Hongdae can be more expensive.

Q: I don't speak Korean. Will that be a problem on campus?

A: Chung-Ang University students will live in the dorms and support participants with campus life.
