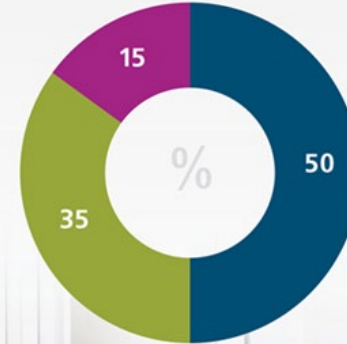

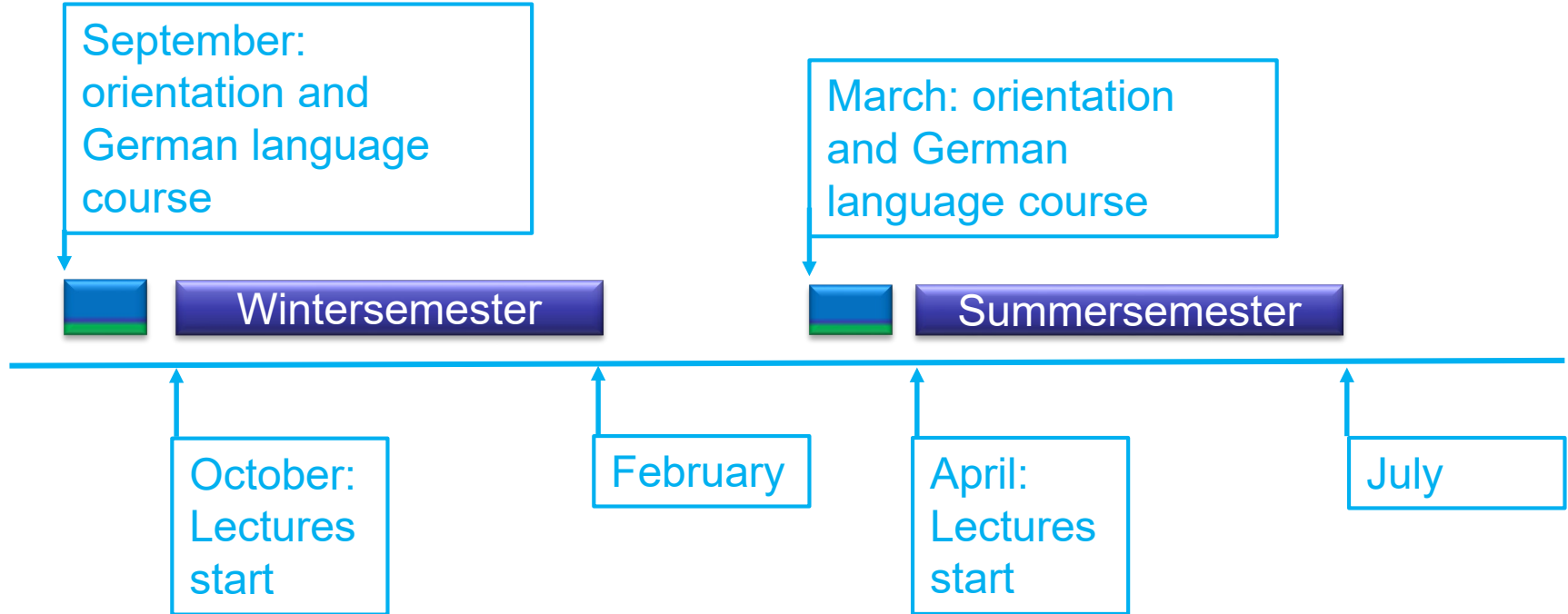



Buddy programme

The International Office of the Faculty of Architecture organizes a buddy programme to support students from abroad during their start and their studies at the TU Darmstadt. All students of the faculty can participate in the programme. For local students who take part in one of the exchange programmes (like e.g. Erasmus+) participation in the buddy programme is mandatory.

The tasks of the buddies include, for example

- support after the arrival in Germany like e.g. with administrative procedures and accommodation
- establishing the contact between the students from abroad and the students of the Faculty of Architecture at the Technical University of Darmstadt.
- the settling in Darmstadt and at the Technical University of Darmstadt to facilitate through joint activities.
- giving advice during the semester.

Approximate Living Costs

Here are the approximate living costs calculated for the average student studying in Darmstadt:

Tuition	EUR 0
Registration fees	→ Current registration fees
Residence Permit for Non-EU	EUR 100 for one year, EUR 110 for more than one year
Housing	EUR 300 – 450 per month (depending on the type of accommodation)
Food & Beverages	EUR 250 – 350 per month
Learning material	approx. EUR 50
Health insurance (for further information see "Health Insurance / Bank Account" → here)	EUR 105 per month
Phone & Internet	EUR 35 – 50 per month
GEZ*	EUR 17.50 per month
Estimated living expenses are about 700.00€ – 900.00€ per month.	

*GEZ is a joint organization of Germany's public broadcasting institutions (radio and TV). Everyone who registers in Germany is required to pay these fees even if you are not a German citizen.

Jobs & Part-time Work

International students can work while studying at TU Darmstadt.

- Students from EU, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland: access to German job market without restrictions
- International Students from all other countries: can work up to 120 full days or 240 half days per year, but cannot be self-employed or freelancers



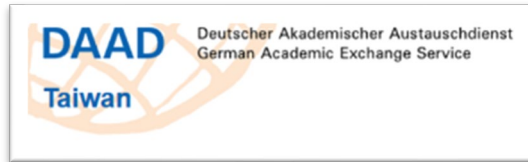
