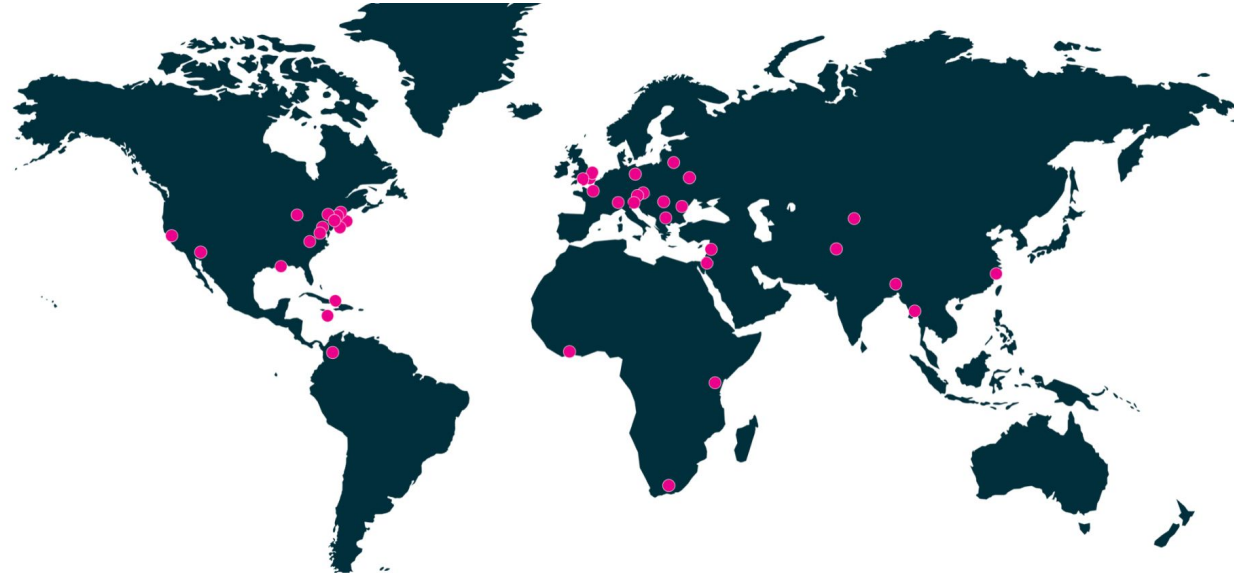

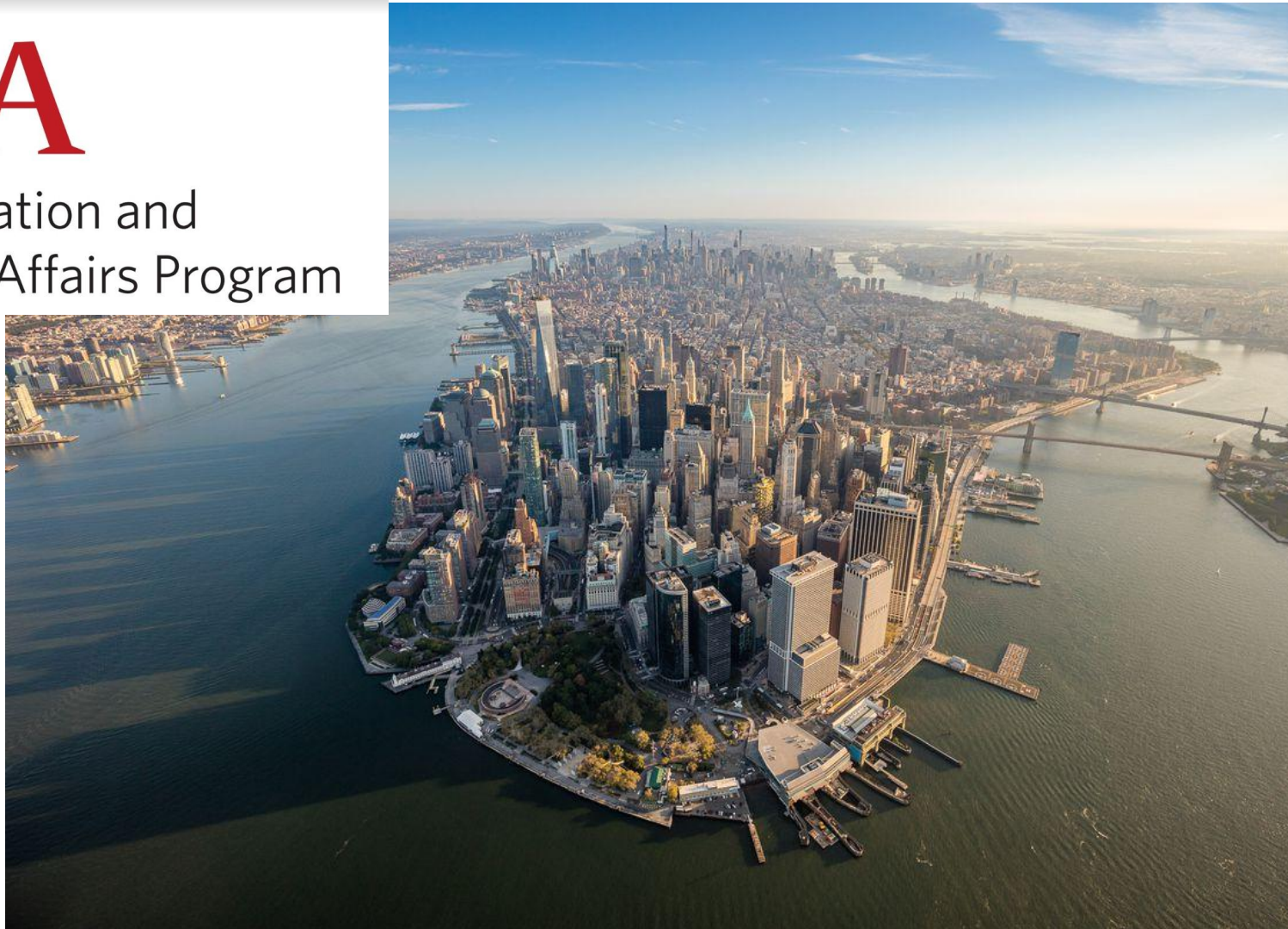

- Classes are held at BGIA's offices in Manhattan, near Times Square (39th St & Broadway)

Housing:

- Students live in dorms in Williamsburg, Brooklyn

Simon's Rock offers an innovative curriculum in the liberal arts and sciences, taught by supportive, highly trained faculty, who are leading scholars in their field. Simon's Rock is the only college in the United States specifically designed for students ready to enter college after the 10th or 11th grade and begin working on their Bachelor's Degree two years early.

There are approximately 400 early college students on the Simon's Rock campus, representing 37 U.S. states and more than 15 countries. The early college students share the campus with 9th & 10th grade students of Bard Academy and traditional and non-traditional age students of the Bard Queer Leadership Project. Affiliated programs and research centers, including the Early College Research Institute, the Center for Food and Resilience, and the Mount Everett Early College Program, also enhance the campus experience.

Opportunities at Simon's Rock

OSUN Food Studies Certificate

Simon's Rock offers the OSUN Certificate in Food Studies, which provides a path for students to deepen their theoretical and applied knowledge of food studies with particular emphasis on sustainability and local practices. Certificate components include approved courses at OSUN campuses, "Courses-in-the-Field" offering students extensive experiences on site in agricultural spaces, and co-curricular hours in food-related work environments of the students choosing.

The Center for Food Studies advances the community's knowledge of food as a cultural force and raises awareness of our responsibilities as stewards of a sustainable food system through integrating food studies into existing Simon's Rock programs.

Bard Queer Leadership Project (BQLP)

A revolutionary B.A. degree program aiming to elevate LGBTQIA+ college graduates into leadership roles in fields across the workforce, while serving as a space for envisioning and actualizing educational practices designed for LGBTQIA+ students to thrive.

The presence of the BQLP and Bard College at Simon's Rock on the same campus allows for course-sharing and other synergies between the two, with multiple pathways into BQLP. Students of all identities are welcome to take BQLP classes and participate in BQLP events. For straight allies interested in careers focused on LGBTQIA+ serving occupations, BQLP can provide a crucial space for training and network-building.

Simon's Rock in Montserrat

The Bard College at Simon's Rock Signature Program in Montserrat is an opportunity for students to engage both theoretically and practically in tropical ecology, conservation biology, and island and global sustainability issues. During this four week program, students study the island's ecology, including endangered and endemic species; receive training in ecological survey methods including snorkeling and coral reef survey techniques; and explore island sustainability issues with respect to climate change.

Montserrat is home to the Soufrière Hills volcano, a recently active volcano in the Caribbean. The island contains numerous rare plants and animals, including over 800 species of plants, 1,240 invertebrates, and at least two critically endangered species found nowhere else in the world.
