

B. 國外研修之課程學習 (課內) · 另外推薦受益最多/最喜歡的課程

Artificial Intelligence: Classical Principles 人工智慧:古典原理 ★★

這門課介紹了人工智慧的基本概念，適合已經掌握程式語言並對人工智慧有興趣的學生。課程以聽講為主，包含六次作業與一次 bonus 作業。前幾次的作業主要是簡單的演算法，後期則包括了前向推理和後向推理。作業的繳交方式是執行程式並向老師展示，並進行簡單的問答。期末考試是筆試，考題會提前公布，學生需依據對相關知識的理解來回答問題。

Functional Programming 函數式程式設計 ★★★

這門課主要是學習 Haskell，一種與過往所學程式語言截然不同的語言，並且在思考模式上也有很大的不同。課程包含四次作業，每次作業的繳交需要先在线上預約時間，並展示程式碼給老師，老師會詢問一些問題來幫助學生更深入理解程式碼的意義。期末考試也是筆試，考題根據課程內容，學生需要手寫程式碼。

C. 國外研修之生活學習 (課外)

在開學初，學校舉辦了 Orientation Day 與舊城區導覽，讓新生和交換生能夠了解周邊環境並認識新朋友。

ESN (歐洲交換學生計畫) 是一個由交換生組成的學生組織，負責舉辦各種活動。在學期間，幾乎每週都有不同的活動，如 International dinner、Culture night 等，讓來自世界各地的學生能夠進行文化交流，這些活動既有趣又充滿教育意義。

在歐洲國內旅行非常方便，無論是搭乘火車或是飛機，都能輕鬆到達其他國家。這讓我有機會與來自其他學校的交換生一同旅行，並獨自探索歐洲，這些經歷讓我收穫良多。

在年末時，許多人生病，我也不幸感染。當時我吃了自己從台灣帶來的成藥，但一個星期後仍然發燒未見好轉，最終忍不住去診所就醫。當時我發現看醫生通常需要預約，因而延誤了幾天才見到醫生。

F. 海外生活期間是否曾遭遇文化衝擊，您如何去面對及適應？

在歐洲，許多地方的水龍頭可以直接喝水，這讓我剛開始有些不習慣，一開始我還堅持購買瓶裝水。後來習慣了之後，我開始直接從水龍頭接水喝。

歐洲的店鋪通常都早早打烊，所以購物時最好一次性把需要的東西買齊。

另外，歐洲的交通大多採用信任制，許多地方不會有人檢查車票或打卡。若被查到逃票，會面臨高額罰款。這種信任制的方式讓我印象深刻，並覺得非常有趣。

在歐洲，行人擁有很大的路權，每當行人過馬路時，汽車會立即停下來禮讓行人。這讓我感受到與台灣不同的交通文化，並且覺得十分舒適。

這段海外生活讓我接觸到了各種不同的文化，讓我更加開放與包容，並且能夠更從容地與來自世界各地的人相處。我的國際視野得到了拓展，並且更加理解與尊重多元文化的價值。

英文心得

Introduction

Studying abroad has always been a dream of mine, but due to financial constraints, it seemed like an unattainable goal. However, after learning about the Cheng Feng Wan Li Scholarship, I decided to apply, hoping it could help me fulfill this aspiration. Fortunately, I was awarded the scholarship, which allowed me to embark on an unforgettable journey of academic and personal growth in Lithuania.

University and Courses

I studied at Vilnius University, the oldest university in the Baltic region, founded in 1579. The campus is rich in historical and cultural heritage, reflecting centuries of academic and intellectual development. Vilnius University offers a diverse range of disciplines, attracting students and scholars from all over the world.

During my exchange, I enrolled in several courses, but the two that impacted me the most were **Artificial Intelligence: Classical Principles** and **Functional Programming**. The AI course provided fundamental knowledge about artificial intelligence, including basic algorithms and concepts like forward and backward chaining. Assignments required students to demonstrate code execution and answer related questions, which helped reinforce my understanding. The final exam was a written test that required applying learned concepts to problem-solving.

The **Functional Programming** course introduced me to Haskell, which was vastly different from the programming

languages I had previously learned. The paradigm shift required me to adopt a new way of thinking about coding. Assignments were submitted through scheduled sessions with the professor, where we had to present our code and answer questions. This interactive approach deepened my comprehension of functional programming. The final exam consisted of writing Haskell code by hand, testing my ability to apply the knowledge acquired throughout the semester.

Life Abroad and Cultural Adaptation

Vilnius University organized an **Orientation Day** and a city tour for new students, which helped me get familiar with my surroundings and meet other exchange students. The **Erasmus Student Network (ESN)** played a significant role in making my experience enjoyable. They organized various events, such as **International Dinners** and **Culture Nights**, allowing students from different backgrounds to connect and share their cultures.

Traveling within Europe was incredibly convenient. I had the chance to explore multiple countries, sometimes with friends and sometimes alone. Each experience was unique and enriched my perspective on different cultures and ways of life.

Challenges and Growth

When I first arrived in Lithuania, my assigned student buddy promised to pick me up at the airport but never showed up. This unexpected situation forced me to find my way to the dormitory alone. Although stressful, it taught me to be independent and resourceful in unfamiliar environments.

Toward the end of my exchange, I fell ill along with many others. Initially, I relied on medicine I had brought from Taiwan, but after a week of persistent fever, I had no choice but to see a doctor. I discovered that in Lithuania, medical consultations usually require appointments, which delayed my treatment. This experience taught me the importance of understanding a country's healthcare system in advance.

Cultural differences also required some adjustments. In Europe, tap water is generally safe to drink, but only the cold water. Initially, I insisted on buying bottled water, but eventually, I adapted. Many stores closed earlier than in Taiwan, so I had to plan my shopping trips carefully. Public transportation relied on an honor system, where passengers were expected to buy and validate tickets themselves. Getting caught without a ticket resulted in hefty fines. Additionally, European traffic laws strongly prioritize pedestrians. Cars would stop immediately when I approached a crosswalk, a level of courtesy that was surprising yet pleasant.
