在課程學習方面,因為我是從什麼都不會而開始學起,一方面的好處是,老師會非常有耐心而且把你當作一張白紙在教,因此學習的過程是直接以日文教授日文,在學習上也比較不會因為有多透過一個語言而有所隔閡,課堂的所有老師都非常的有耐心,因此千萬不要害怕問問題,語言這種東西就是多使用就學的快!而在學校當中,有一個被稱為 BBP 的地方,那是所有想要語言交換的學生所聚集的地方,不單單只有日語的交流,其他國語言也是可以做交流的。

而在修習完一年的課程後,我也能夠順暢的與日本人做溝通聊天,當然沒學過的單字就真的沒有辦法理解,必須靠平常多背單字使用,但日常溝通的文法在學校所教的課程當中,大約 80% 都會概括到,因此努力認真上課,下課多與日本人做交流,日語能力是會進步非常快的!尤其我住在宿舍中,宿舍當中有樓長,大部分皆為日本人,他們也都很樂意和你聊天出遊,因此不要擔心說會不會只有在課堂上會使用到日文而已,課後之於多結交日本朋友也有助於日文的學習。

Ritsumeikan University is a private university in Kyoto, Japan. It has four campuses in total. The main campus is the Kinugasa campus, which is also the campus with the most people. The Department of International Relations in the school is the most famous department.

The course I was taking is the IJL course, and all the teaching content is Japanese learning, and I have not taken additional courses. In terms of course learning, because I started learning nothing, on the one hand, the advantage is that the teacher will be very patient and teach you, so the learning process is taught directly in Japanese to Japanese. All the teachers in the classroom are very patient, so don't be afraid to ask questions. Language is something that you can learn quickly if you use it more! And in the school, there is a place called BBP, which is where all the students who want to exchange languages gather. Not only Japanese can be used for communication, but other languages can also be used for communication. And after completing the one-year course, I can also communicate and chat with Japanese smoothly. Of course, I can't understand the words that I haven't learned before. I lived in the dormitory, there is a building manager in the dormitory. Some of them are Japanese, and they are also very happy to chat and travel with you, so don't worry about whether you will only use Japanese in class. Making more Japanese friends after class is also helpful for Japanese learning. Outside of the classroom, it is also necessary to participate in a lot of activities, the most famous izakaya culture and community culture in Japan. In the dormitory, everyone is interested in Japanese culture, so they come to experience life. On weekends, after a week of intensive Japanese classes, of course, I would go to an izakaya to chat with friends from other countries and experience the real Japanese life in the local area. On the one hand, you can have cultural exchanges with people from other countries and improve your English skills. When you go with Japanese friends, you can also learn about Japanese izakaya culture after work through Japanese. And Japan's community culture is also very active. The clubs here are not restricted by the school's department, so their development is particularly vigorous. Of course, the common language in the club is mainly Japanese, so if you join, the basic communication will be in Japanese, which will also be of great help in Japanese learning. Whether it's autumn scenery or spring cherry blossoms, the beauty of Japan will give you in a good mood.
