26-1 學校簡介

首爾大學是一所位於韓國首爾的國立大學。最早的直接前身是朝鮮高宗在 1895 年創建的法官養成所,後來的京城法學專門學校。1946 年,由大韓民國政府利用京城大學在內的 10 間學校的資源,成立首爾大學,是韓國國立旗艦大學中的一所。首爾大學(Seoul National University)與高麗大學(Korea University)和延世大學(Yonsei University),三所學校的英文名稱首字合併後,並稱為韓國大學的「一片天」(SKY),並與韓國科技院及成均館大學在各項大學排行榜上常列前五大。

26-2 國外研修之課程學習(課內)

我在首爾大學就讀的是資訊工程學系,一方面是因為他們沒有資訊管理學系,所以我選擇一個比較同領 域的學系,另一方面是因為我想要上上看他們資工系的課程,享受一下頂尖的資訊課程洗禮。 我這學期修了兩門課,一門是他們的通識課程「人際關係的心理學」,該課程使用韓文上課,開學時老 師會幫大家分組,把年紀、科系、性別不同的人放在同一組,以增進討論時的多元性。我們這一組總共 有八位同學,有法文系的、政治系的、醫學系的、造船系的、電機系的...真的都來自不同領域。每週需 要針對課堂內容的討論議題分享自己的想法,大部分都是日常生活中的經驗,像是「我人生中最重要的 朋友是誰?為什麼?怎麼認識的?」這種討論內容,並彙整繳交一份討論紀錄。這門課沒有期中考,但 是有期末考、期末小組作品、期末個人報告書,還要配合心理研究所的研究參與實驗。期末考的內容是 整個學期的教學內容,形式是筆試,包含了選擇題跟簡答題。期末小組作品呈現方式十分多元,老師甚 至說可以用默劇或是合唱的方式呈現(據說老師比較不喜歡無聊的 ppt 報告),幾乎可以說是沒有任何限 制,只要內容跟人際關係這個主軸有關係就可以。我們這組選擇拍攝微電影,復刻了韓國已停播的高人 氣綜藝節目「SNL Korea」的三分鐘系列,運用了我們在課堂上學到的心理學理論,獲得了很棒的迴 響。其他組的呈現方式也很有趣,有的模仿熱門戀愛時境秀,製作了類似的相親節目,有的製作組員們 改善自身人際關係的紀錄片,有的則以話劇呈現。而個人報告書的部分,需要寫滿 4-5 頁的 A4,字體大 小限制為 10,內容是針對自身人際關係的改善與結果報告。這門課是以 pr 值來給等第分數。另外一門 課是資工系的 seminar,內容就是跟我們本校資管系系上的 seminar 差不多,唯一的差別是首爾大的卡司 真的很厲害!演講者中不乏創業人士、或是像是一些大公司的主管(Line、三星等等), Line 的演講者甚 至準備了抱枕等周邊商品送給答對問題的同學,真的很大方!這門課只要缺席不超過三次就可以通過。 26-3 國外研修之生活學習(課外)

1. Introduction Of SNU

Founded in 1946, Seoul National University is considered to be the most prestigious university in the country. The university has three campuses: the main campus in Gwanak and two additional campuses in Daehangno and Pyeongchang. The university comprises sixteen colleges, one graduate school and nine professional schools. The student body consists of nearly 17,000 undergraduate and 11,000 graduate students. According to data compiled by KEDI, the university spends more on its students per capita than any other university in the country that enrolls at least 10,000 students.

Lessons

In this semester, I took two lessons, and they were all taught in Korean. One is called "Psychology Of Interpersonal Relationship". In this class, we have an 8-people group which consists of students from different backgrounds on the purpose of discussion diversity. We have class group discussion in every class, and we have to hand in a report after it. There is no midterms for this class, but we have a final, a personal report of our own personal relationship improvement and a group project. For the grading, it is based on the percentage of performances. (i.e: top 30% will get A+). The another class I took is the seminar of our department. It is quite similar with the one we have in NSYSU MIS. And for the grading, it is mainly based on the appearance. If you do not skip more than 3 classes, then you can pass it.

Extracurricular Activities

I am a member of the school club called "SNU Buddy" this semester. It is a school club that has some Korean buddies to help foreign students with their lives in SNU. I made many good friends there and had unforgettable memories. During this semester, we have several activities like wearing Han-bok(the traditional custom) in the palace, drinking So-Ju in a Korean bar, having "member training" trip in Gangwondo, and also watched the professional baseball game in Jamsil stadium. I really recommend foreign students to sign up for the club.

First, do not bring "IWC plugs" with you. Since most of the sockets in Korea are hollow, the IWC plugs may not fit them. So I recommend you to bring the simplest plugs with you when you visit Korea. If you did not have any with you, you can also get them in convenience stores on campus. Second, when you need to catch a taxi, I

recommend an app called "Kakao T". It works like "Uber", and you can enter the definition at first to avoid unreasonable charging. Also, since some taxi drivers are around age 40-60, and may not be good at English, you can avoid these problems by using Kakao T. Last but not least, always be careful and keep your attention when traveling around by yourself. Because there are more and more crimes happening in Korea these days. Besides, it would be better if you just pretend that you are a local when being alone, since a "foreigner" may be a target for stalkers and criminals.
