

荷蘭 烏特列支大學返國報告書

學校簡介

烏特列支大學是位在荷蘭中北部的一所歷史相當悠久的綜合型大學。學校的系所相當多，學生人數也很多；此外，學校的校園是開放式的校園，校內有相當多雄偉的建築物及一個小型的運河，交通也相當便利，學生可以搭公車或自己騎腳踏車到達烏特列支市中心去買東西或逛街。

國外研修之課程學習（課內）

此次交換期間我修習了 International Strategic Management, Topics in Corporate Finance 和 Strategy and Innovation 三門課。這三門課都是 International Business Management 碩士班開的課程。

International Strategic Management 和 Strategy and Innovation 兩門課的架構差不多，都有期末考（內容包括課本，上課 case study 及 ppt,）還有分組上台報告；課程很扎實，教授每週講課都非常精彩，只是整體來說不算很輕鬆，需要花不少時間準備報告及期末考的筆試。

至於 Topics in Corporate Finance 這門課則 100%只看期末筆試成績，期末考考了四題申論題，考試時間 3 小時；這門課每週都會有助教帶大家做題目，考前助教也會提醒一些該注意的事項。只是這門課是我認為三門當中最課業最重的，每週都要不斷的計算各種財務相關的題目，建議有修習過財務相關課程的同學再來修這門課比較適當。

國外研修之生活學習（課外）

我在荷蘭交換期間也拜訪了阿姆斯特丹，鹿特丹，海牙及羊角村等城市；荷蘭的國鐵(NS) 非常的準時且便利，如果從烏特列支搭火車到阿姆斯特丹或鹿特丹等城市只要大約 40 分鐘就到了，單趟價位約在 10 歐元上下。此外，來荷蘭必須要品嚐當地的薯條，荷式鬆餅，蘋果派以及海尼根啤酒等道地美食，絕對會是難以忘懷的體驗！當然，荷蘭也是消費相當高的國家，如果在外面買一份麥當勞套餐或漢堡套餐基本上都要 6~10 歐元左右。因此，到荷蘭一定要注意自己每週在外面消費的額度，以免一不小心花超過自己能負擔的程度。

而荷蘭的治安相當良好，人民的素養也相當高；只要你開口尋求幫助，荷蘭人基本都很樂意幫忙你。並且就算到晚上七八點吃完飯在大街上走路，都不太需要擔心會遇到扒手或不友善的人。

整體來說，荷蘭是個很當乾淨，人民素質，公務員素質相當高的國家。基本上只要你有任何問題，荷蘭人都很願意幫忙你。此外，荷蘭的大眾交通運輸系統包括公車，輕軌或巴士等都相當密集，所以不用擔心交通不便等問題。

所以我相當推薦未來要來荷蘭交換的同學能多搭火車到不同的城市去逛逛，看一看各地的建築，品嚐各地的荷式美食，同時也要記得買一台腳踏車，享受騎車逛城市的樂趣，在荷蘭買一臺二手腳踏車大概要 60~100 歐元左右，所以建議同學可以到當地後貨比三家再買，因為有時候不同店賣的價差蠻大的。

English Version:

Throughout the time when I was exchanging in Utrecht University, I experienced many culture differences in the Netherlands. First of all, the Netherlands was an absolute high-quality country in terms of its public transportation as well as the kind attitude of Dutch people; you will always receive friendly responses whenever you're in need; also, you can savor all kinds of well-architected Dutch-style buildings gathered on the sides in which the cities you visit. Second, you must try all kinds of savory Dutch food including apple pie, Dutch pan cakes, Dutch fries and Dutch beers, they will always make your day perfect. Third, the Netherlands is a country full of canals, you will see all sorts of canals stretching through cities like Amsterdam, Rotterdam, the Hague, and so on. So please try to visit some famous cities in Netherlands, you won't regret it. Fourth, buying or renting a bike to ride is quite a compulsory thing to do in the Netherlands; you can see dozens of Dutch people riding their bikes to work or to school, it's one of the most fascinating part to see in the Netherlands. Last, the weather in the Netherlands in September to November will range from 15~5 Celsius degrees. The temperature will plunge to 2~-5 in December to early February, so please beware to bring or buy heavy coats in winter times.

Furthermore, I chose three courses which are International Strategic Management, Topics in Corporate Finance and Strategy and Innovation. Both International Strategic Management and Strategy and Innovation required a lot of reading and in-class discussion. Also, we have one or two group presentation in these classes. So, it recommended to stay focused on the topics which the professor talked about every week so as to keep up the discussion with your partners in your group. Another thing noticeable is that you better finish reading the whole textbook before last two weeks in order to review all the chapters covered in the book, because the final exam will usually base heavily the on the textbook. As for Topics in Corporate Finance, we had tutorials every week with an additional professor teaching us how to calculate and manage the details regarding the designated case in that week. But this course went through a lot of Finance-related concepts as well as calculations like Black-Sholes Model in European Option Pricing field and also

NPV,APV and Pay Back Period calculating; so, it' s highly recommended only the students with at least a few finance or economics background to take this class. Last, this class didn't require any presentations, it only scored on its final exam.

All in all, life in the Netherlands was an amazing and unforgettable journey. I fully recommend future students to exchange to the Netherlands to enjoy a period of cycling time in your life and also don't forget to travel through different cities in the Netherlands as well!
