## 國立三重大學返國報告書

## 學校簡介

三重大學位於三重縣津市,津市位於三重縣北部,屬於東海地區。雖然三重縣不是一個很有名的縣市,卻是個富有歷史感的地方,擁有日本第一神宮「伊勢神宮」、還有伊賀「忍者」,這些都為了三重縣增添了更多與其他大城市不一樣的風采。而三重大學位於三重縣津市江戶橋的日本國立大學。經常被稱為「海邊校區」,所有學部都集中在近鉄江戶橋站附近一處。農林水產專業的研究有較長的歷史,在改組為生物資源學部的時候,成為包括農林水產的自然科學、社會科學、理工學的綜合學部。

## 學校課程

交換學生通常會在國際中心上日本語的課程,三重大學的日語課程分成「初級123」、「中級12」、「上級」,共六個班。其中又以中級班的課程人數最多,每班約40人以上,所以在學習成效上,可能帶有一點限制。不過如果是沒有基礎的同學,在初級班可以進步很快。三重大學的日文用書從初級班到中級一都是使用「大家的日本語」,所以如果在台灣有學過日文的話建議直接帶自己的書,因為在日本當地買有點貴。但是在三重大學的日文課,似乎是比較偏向讓正規留學生能夠在學部銜接上,所以比較重視「寫」的能力,比較不重視學生「會話」的能力,想要會話進步的話,需要靠自己的努力。

三重大學的分班方式,是採用檢定考的形式,但是並不會按照個別的能力分班,有時候會導致一個 班級當中能力不一,但是老師又沒辦法照顧到班上每一個人,所以很常需要靠自己學習。但是老師很樂 意在課餘時間和大家互動,所以當有日文問題的時候不要害怕去問老師,另外三重大學的國際中心,也 時常會安排一些見習活動以及一些實習機會,讓大家不只從學校教育中學習,更可以拓展至社會方面。 三重大的課外生活 三重大學有一個「Tutor」制度,留學生可以跟指導老師提出,找一個協助留學生不管是課業上或是生活上一切問題的日本學生,他們會在課餘時間跟負責的學生見面,一起鍊習日文,或是一起出去玩。但是,如果不是國際中心的老師,可能在尋找Tutor的過程中可能比較困難,並且也不是每一個Tutor都是很好相處的,所以有時候需要看運氣。但是我覺得,對於練習日文會話是個不可多得的機會,因為除了去參加社團有機會和日本人交朋友外,其他的有點困難。

在課外練習日文會話,還有一個是和其他的留學生一起練習。雖然大家用的都不是最正確的日文,但是畢竟每天相處最久的就是同學們,而且大部分的人都很樂意開口跟彼此聊天,所以我們彼此都是彼此的老師,所以在大家一起開口亂講的過程中,日文也是一點一滴地在進步。

留學生的假日其實是很忙的,通常大家都會三五成群的結伴出遊,雖然三重縣不是一個富有觀光地的地方,但是它所孕育的日本歷史文化是非常豐富的,例如:日本第一神宮伊勢神宮、大家都知道能代表日本特色的伊賀忍者,都是在三重這個地方所孕育出來的。所以不管在課堂上,或是在課餘時間都是吸收各種知識的好時機。

在交換學生的這段期間,我覺得對於我個人來說,是一個不可多得的經驗,在三重大學這個地方,我第一次在離家那麼遠的地方生活,一開始說不緊張當然是騙人的,但是在這裡生活之後,可以發現願意提供我們幫助的人很多,所以勇敢的踏出舒適圈,精進自己的語言能力、社交能力。我認為學校能夠提供我們出國交換的這個機會,真的對我的人生起了很大的幫助。

Because of this club, i made a lot of friends over there , we usually hang out every weekend and have fun with them.
