Enrich your global perspective and become acquainted with the cultural diversity and complexity of a foreign economic environment. Our region is famous for its vibrant culture and rich historical background that is still reflecting on today's life.

Sample the local specialties and the great wines of the Palatinate vineyards and explore Heidelberg with its impressive castle and its unique historic city center. ## Residencies

Residencies are group short-term programs which are specifically customized to the participants' needs and preferences. Your participants will gain new insights and perspectives through the interaction with students of all levels as well as the exchange with corporate experts sharing their firsthand knowledge. On average residencies last five to seven days.

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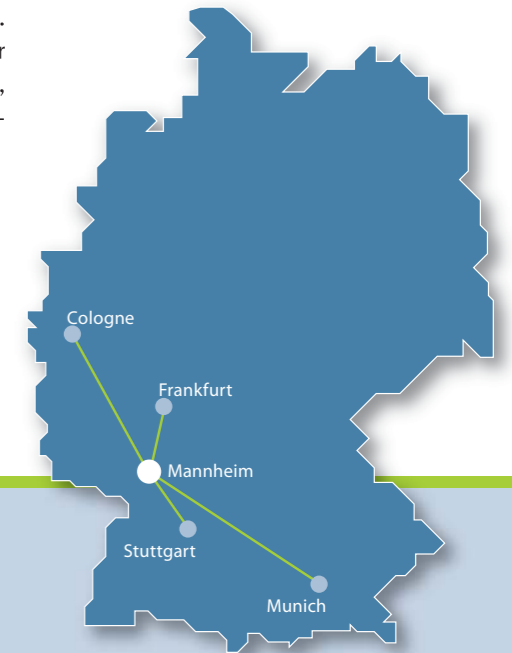
## Summer School

The Summer School is designed for individuals seeking a truly international experience in Germany combined with a deepening of their business knowledge. During the Summer School, graduate and advanced undergraduate business students from all over the world come together to learn about and become acquainted with German business practices and German culture.

The program consists of three 10-day modules, each covering one specific business topic. Students can freely combine these modules, i.e., they can select one or two modules or attend the entire program. Each module ends with a final exam. After having successfully completed a module, Mannheim grades the student's performance and awards 4 ECTS credits.

A small group size of no more than 25 students ensures close student-teacher as well as student-student interaction. Thus, students can also learn from each other as they share their unique business knowledge and diverse cultural background. The program is conducted in English and takes place every year in June/July.
